

Decision-making tree for level 2 in person contact

Although the latest data suggests there is a low prevalence of COVID-19 in the community, the Government is prioritising the detection of COVID-19, reducing the risk of silent community transmission during Level 2 and protection of the people who are at most risk of contracting COVID-19. Health workers are a high risk group of both contracting and transmitting COVID-19. The management of these risks needs to be balanced with continuing to provide equitable and essential health and disability services.
